

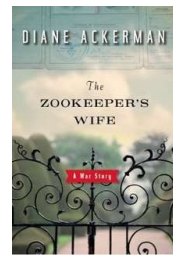
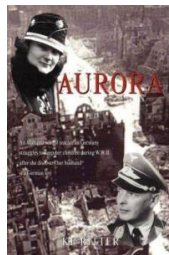
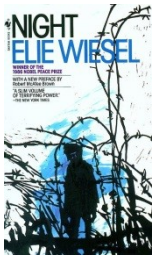
Lessons from the Holocaust: An Interfaith Book Club
