The five-week seminar will meet once a week in a classroom or by Zoom, for 90 minutes. Our Training Teachers program allows them to educate their students with newly learned content.

The knowledge gained during these month-long sessions, while deeply disturbing, is also very inspiring and life affirming. There is no better teacher than history, because the past becomes the present. Through teaching the Holocaust, everyone comes away determined to foster tolerance and respect in and out of the classroom and to inoculate students against the dangers of blind obedience and mindless conformity.

From a teacher's perspective, the trainings provide everything: histories of specific events, teaching strategies, student lessons, and

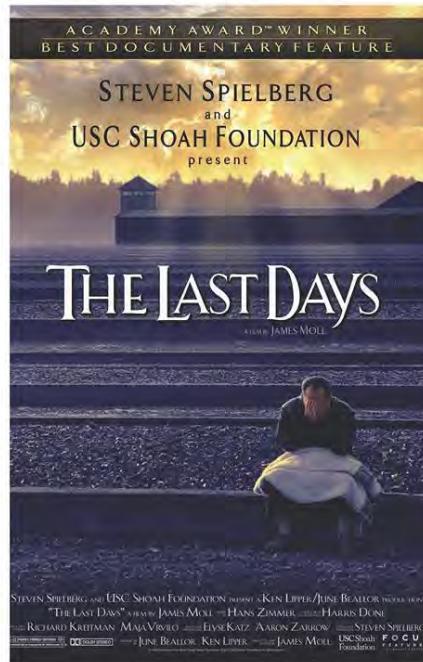
